MAYER AM PFARRPLATZ Winery

Niederösterreich region (Lower Austria), Vienna

The Mayer am Pfarrplatz winery is a symbol of Viennese wine culture, with a history dating back to 1683 and today it is one of the best white wine producers in Austria.

The vineyards are located in the cadaster of the capital city of Vienna, which is (together with Würzburg, Germany) the largest wine city in Europe.



LIGHT, VERY DRINKABLE SEMI-DRY WINE

Appellation: Niederösterreich (Lower Austria – area between Mikulov and Vienna)

Varieties: Gr. Vetliner 30%, Pinot Blanc 30%, Riesling 30%, Traminer 10%

Description: Seductive fruity exoticism, elegant nutmeg and rose scent. Balanced and lively on the palate with only a subtle residual sweetness in the finish.

Serve at: 8-10°C

Food recommendation: Asian cuisine

Vinification: fermentation in a stainless-steel tank

Residual sugar: 12g/litre
